



Why do we have the curriculum we do?

- 1) A curriculum that pupils can pick up, at any time when they join
- 2) A curriculum that demonstrates the TAS ethos and creativity
- 3) Curriculum for each Key Stage which allows transition from one to the next
- 4) A flexible approach to learning
- 5) A curriculum that can be as hands on as the teacher makes it
- 6) Learning to be encouraged outside of the classroom as much as possible
- 7) ICT available for all pupils and staff, to be able to go paperless
- 8) A way of developing strong Speaking and Listening with pupils
- 9) A dedicated person to facilitate exams and qualifications
- 10) Embed the Duke of Edinburgh back into the curriculum for year 9,10,11
- 11) Embed JAS Award for KS2 and KS3 as a pre-Duke of Edinburgh option
- 12) Robust MATHS & ENGLISH lessons daily
- 13) Added on-line qualifications for pupils to study and build their portfolio
- 14) A way of developing well rounded individuals, with the skills needed to progress back to mainstream, college or employment
- 15) Differentiated for all levels of pupils that come through our doors, but also accessible for those pupils on our virtual learning programme
- 16) Achievements recognised and accredited throughout the year
- 17) One day a week dedicated to exam practice and functional skills
